Seminar work

- Most important for training of PhD-students.
- Need to get experience in presenting and discussing research.
- Broader audience than discussion with supervisor.
- Looking for opportunities to receive interesting comments to own research is one of most important tasks of young researchers.

PhD-program

- Curriculum includes two seminar presentation.
- Supervisor and two more professors have to attend the presentations, in addition to PhD-students.
- Participating students are encouraged to ask questions and express comments.

Additional opportunities

- Department seminar. Regular guest-speakers from other universities and research institutions. Offers opportunities for students to see most recent research by colleagues.
- Occasional presentation of ongoing research by faculty members (even at initial stage).
- Yearly department two-day workshops with presentations of faculty members as well as guests.
