Realize researches

- Define and articulate a research question (formulate a research hypothesis)
- Identify possible sources of information
- Select the most appropriate research methods (surveys, interviews, experiments) and research tools (periodical indexes, databases, websites).
- Plan the research project
- Retrieve information using a variety of methods
- Revise hypothesis as necessary
- Use information effectively for a specific purpose
- Understand such issues as plagiarism, ownership of information
- Cite properly
